
Intended use

This strong bathing aid helps those with difficulty getting in or out of the bath. The Derby bath board is made as a one-piece plastic moulding, making it lightweight and strong, hygienic and easy to use. It has a range of improvements over a standard bath board, such as a coccyx cutaway for comfort and a soap dish at both ends. The slatted design allows water to drain away quickly, without creating an entrapment risk. It is fixed to the bath using four independent rubber ended pillars, which are positioned to fit securely in a variety of different bath shapes, fitting snugly against the sides of the bath.

An optional handle is available. This is anchored directly to the pillars through the bath board, on the side nearest to the wall, to give the user a firm gripping point. This bath board is suitable for baths 440mm – 630mm measured inside width.



WARNING! This user manual must be read before using the bath board. Severe injury or death may result if user instructions, maintenance instructions and product warnings are not followed.






Safe use



WARNING! The decision to use this bath board should always be guided by a qualified Health Care Professional, who can also advise and assist with the correct usage instruction.


- Do not exceed the safe working load of 190kg.
- Only use on baths with an internal width of 440mm - 630mm
- Check that the bath board is firmly assembled before use.
- Ensure that the board is stable on the bath sides and cannot move.
- Inspect at regular intervals for wear and damage. Remove from use immediately if faults are found.
- Supervision or assistance when using the bath board is recommended for users with limited mobility.
- The product is suitable for use in baths; it is not suitable for use in swimming pools.
- The bath board can be slippery when wet—use this product with caution.
- Do not tip or put an offset load onto the bath board or injury may occur.
- Do not stand on the bath board.
- Use the bath board only for the purpose it is intended for.




Instructions for use

Installing the bath board

- 1. Check the bath board is free from damage.
- 2. Fasten two pillars at each end of the bath board through the outermost slots with two screws. If fitting the handle to the board, insert the screws into the holes in the handle before putting through the board and screwing into the pillars (see diagram 1).



- 3. Position the bath board over the bath ensuring that the rear upstand is on top.
- 4. Adjust the pillars for a secure fit against the sides of the bath (see diagram 2).



Avoid the board overhanging the side of the bath.

5. Tighten the wingnuts to secure the pillars in positions (see diagram 3).



6. Test the board to ensure it is stable on the bath.



WARNING! Before each use check the bath board is in good working order and it is fitted securely in place. Severe injury or death may result if this is not done correctly.



Transferring to a bath board from a wheelchair

- 1. Place the wheelchair so that it faces the front of the tub, next to the board.
- 2. Transfer your torso from the wheelchair to the bench then lift each leg over the side of the tub.
- Slide over until you are sitting in the middle of the bath board. Move slowly and avoid twisting to prevent injuries.
- 4. To transfer back to the wheelchair, slide over to the edge of the board, lift each leg over the tub wall, and then transfer your torso into the wheelchair.

Transferring to a bath board from a standing position

- 1. To transfer to a bath board from a standing position, sit down on the bath board with the back of your legs touching the side of the bath.
- 2. Lift each leg over the side of the tub wall.
- 3. Move your body into the middle of the bath board.
- 4. To get out of the bathtub, move over to the edge of the board, lift each leg over the tub wall, and push yourself up from the bath board.



WARNING! These are general guidelines for transferring onto and off the bath board. Always seek guidance from a Health Care Professional on the correct method for transferring to and from the bath board. Supervision or assistance when using the bath transfer bench is recommended for users with limited mobility.

Care and maintenance

- Dry down after using.
- Clean with a non-abrasive disinfectant.
- DO NOT use abrasive powders or scouring pads to avoid causing corrosion.
- Bath board can be autoclaved.
- Should the equipment appear damaged remove from use immediately.
- Check before each use for wear and damage. Remove from use immediately if faults are found.

Disposal

Products that can no longer be used are to be disposed of separately from household rubbish. This must be done according to the local and national regulations for environmental protection and raw material recycling. Please look at your local council's website for further information on the correct disposal.
